<p>Introduction</p>	<p>Hello my name is Ren Pope and I will be guiding you through today's session. I would like to introduce to you my colleagues.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Dave will act as the computer 2. Jill and Janet will take during today's session <p>Now let me introduce you to Gen-E, short for "Generation Everyone" – a device that can organize individuals while meeting the needs of the entire family. It brings unity to the busy lives of each family member and provides a cohesive structure for planning.</p> <p>This is a prototype of the Gen-E device. Most everything can be done on the touch screen, but Gen-E also has an optional sliding keyboard for more word-intensive tasks. The screen will automatically rotate to landscape when you need to enter text.</p>
<p>Meet the Family</p>	<p>For today's test, you will play the role of Olga, a 21 year old live-in au pair for a family of 5. You are also a college student taking classes at a local college.</p> <p>Now let's meet the family your work for.</p> <p>Adam and Eve are your employers and parents to 3 children. The children: John, Sarah and Carter.</p> <p>Today, we will ask you to use Gen-E while playing the role of Olga. You will use Gen-E to manage schedules and tasks for a day.</p> <p>We understand that this is a lot of information to absorb, so we have provided a sheet with all of the roles for your convenience.</p> <p>We also have all of the tasks in writing if you need to reference them.</p> <p>At this point, do you have any questions?</p>
<p>Start of scenario</p>	<p>Let's get started with today's scenario. Again, you are Olga. As the au pair, you have the ability to manage your schedule and the schedule of the family's children.</p> <p>For the start of the scenario, you are at the Gen-E main application screen. The application screen displays Gen-E's main applications. Today, we will focus On the calendar feature, so let's select calendar from the menu. The schedule is represented by several bars. Each row of bars represents the</p>
